To qualify, all game claims must be ratified by the committee between the closing date of the previous tournament and the closing date of this tournament. However some leeway is allowed for photographic and skin entries. Antlers, tusks, horns and skins must be made available for judging in a clean condition at the AGM venue prior to the start of the AGM. Pig tusks must be drawn and antlers should be attached to the full upper skull. Skins must be from bow shot game that has been claimed, skinned and cured by the entrant. Skins are judged hair side upwards.

<u>Cambridge & Buddle Shield:</u>	Best photo of wildlife taken in a hunting situation (Note: Trail cam photos not eligible)
<u>Len Purser Shield:</u>	Best photo of bow shot game
<u>Tiger Loch-head Trophy:</u>	For literary achievement
<u>Lance Henwood Trophy:</u>	Best prepared skin (big and small game)
<u>Junior Roaring Trophy:</u>	Junior deer roaring
<u>Pine Ridge Shield:</u>	Ladies deer roaring
<u>Norman Taylor Roaring Shield:</u>	Men's deer roaring
<u>David Williamson Trophy:</u>	Notable hunting achievement, awarded by the committee
